




COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE

Participating societies have expressed interest in working collaboratively to enhance IDEA

IDENTIFIED NEEDS

Areas of focus that have emerged from IDEA 1.0 & 2.0 conferences



INFORMATION SHARING

Leveraging existing knowledge, experiences, and resources

- Convene meetings and conferences to raise awareness of ongoing efforts and available resources
- Coordinate networks and activities
- Facilitate information sharing across societies and varied communication platforms
- Disseminate information about relevant initiatives & activities and their outcomes





TOOLS & RESOURCES

Identify and develop shared resources that serve the broader community

- Collate available tools and resources for all aspects of IDEA (e.g., society documents, assessment surveys, guidelines, training, research, etc.)
- Develop additional tools, resources, and best practices to create a comprehensive library
- Integrate tools and resources with other aspects/approaches of IDEA
- Share available resources widely

KNOWLEDGE

Develop and implement training programs that enable culture change

- Assess training needs and engage stakeholders
- Develop training for a variety of audiences
- Offer training through multiple approaches and platforms
- Identify resources and offer consulting and guidance in IDEA for biology societies






REPOSITORY

Build and manage a curated, open repository of shared IDEA resources

- **Create a library of information, including society governance and policy documents (e.g., Bylaws, Constitution, Code of Conduct, Strategic Plans), meeting summaries, etc.**
- **Curate resources such as assessment tools; demographic surveys; and training materials, both formal & peer-to-peer**
- **Promote guidelines & best practices for communications, activities & events, assessments, approaches, governance structures, etc.**
- **Stay up-to-date on relevant research and reports**

ADDRESSING IDENTIFIED NEEDS



WORKING GROUP

Build a formal working group of AIBS member & like-minded organizations to expand IDEA efforts

WORKING GROUP

The working group would collaborate on & develop strategies to sustain our IDEA work & create a community of practice

Responsibilities:

- Strategize to collaboratively address agreed-upon goals to build a community of practice
- Identify and apply for funding opportunities to sustain IDEA efforts, including writing grant proposals
- Plan future meetings and activities
- Serve as steering committee to guide grants
- Identify other individuals & experts to participate in subsequent activities

CREATING THE WORKING GROUP

The working group would include:

- Representatives from AIBS members and other like-minded organizations
- Individual experts

Expectations:

- Time commitment: 1-2 meetings per quarter
- Actively engage in strategizing

Provide a forum for the community regularly to share and learn




SHARE RESOURCES
